

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How I will proceed for online application?

Reply:

- To apply visit www.ntpccareers.net and click on "Recruitment of Diploma Engineer Trainee, ITI Trainee , Lab Assistant Trainee, Assistant (Materials / Store Keeper) Trainee for Darlipalli STPP- 2018" (Only online mode of application is entertained). Read the advertisement of ER-II HQ, Bhubaneswar (available on home page) for which you wish to apply.
- In case of General/ OBC candidates, please take the print out of copy of Pay-in-slip which is available on side menu and make the payment of Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred only) towards registration fee in any branch of State Bank of India. Apply online only after making the payment at SBI and getting the Journal Number. from bank.
- Select the discipline / post for applying (Once selected, discipline / post cannot be changed).
- The application form will appear in the screen. The candidate is required to fill up the application form. Candidate has to upload photograph (applicable for all) Signature (applicable for all) & pay-in-slip (applicable for General/ OBC candidates) in .jpg format (max. file size can be 500 KB). After filling the application form & uploading the jpg files as mentioned above, the candidate will click on Preview button.
- On clicking 'Preview' button, the confirmation page will appear. Here candidate can make some changes/correction in his application by clicking on 'back' button. If no changes are to be done, the candidate can click on 'Submit' button.
- On clicking Submit button, Registration slip will be generated. Keep the Registration slip for future reference. (No need to send the hard copy to us).

2. How I will generate the Bank Pay-in-slip?

Reply: The copy of pay-in-slip is available on the side menu of the website www.ntpccareers.net. On clicking on pay-in-slip, the system will ask for the name of the candidate. Please type your name (name of candidate) and copy of pay-in-slip will be generated.

3. Will NTPC refund the registration fee in case my candidature is rejected due to any reason?

Reply: The registration fee is non-refundable.

4. What are the documents to be uploaded while filling up the online application?

Reply: Scanned copies of photograph (applicable for all), signature (applicable for all) & pay-in-slip (applicable for General/ OBC candidates) are required to be uploaded in .jpg format (max. file size can be 500 KB), while applying for the post online.

5. **I have appeared for my final year/Semester Examinations and the results are expected to be announced shortly. Am I eligible to apply?**
Reply: Final year students, who are expecting their result on or before last date of Online Registration are eligible to apply.
6. **In my Diploma Course only CGPA / GPA / SGPA or letter grade has been awarded in place of percentage of marks. Can I enter the grade in my application?**
Reply: Candidates, who have been awarded CGPA / GPA / SGPA or letter grades, should convert the grades to percentage and provide only the equivalent percentage of marks in the online application form.
7. **I have scored 69.5% marks in my Diploma and belong to General Category. Am I eligible to apply?**
Reply: The minimum percentage requirement in Diploma in Engineering is 70% for General & OBC Category. Hence you are not eligible to apply. However for Darlipalli Project Displaced/ PAP(Land Oustee) in General / OBC category the minimum percentage requirement in Diploma Engineering is 50 %.
8. **I am a Diploma Holder meeting all requirements with respect to Qualifications belonging to the General Category. I am 25 years and 5 days old as on last date of online registration. Am I eligible to apply?**
Reply: The upper age limit of 25 Years is prescribed as on last date of online registration i.e. 19.11.2018. Hence you are not eligible.
9. **I am a SC/ST/OBC candidate but don't have the caste certificate, can I apply as a General candidate?**
Reply: If you so desire, you may apply as General Candidate (if eligible for Gen category) giving your category as "General". In such an event, your candidature will be considered as "GENERAL" and no change in category shall be allowed at a later date.
10. **Will any Travelling Allowance be paid to me for attending the Online Test ?**
Reply: No Travelling Allowance is payable to the candidates for attending the Online Test.
11. **I have forgotten to take the print out of the registration slip, what should I do now?**
Reply: Download your registration slip by visiting the website after furnishing either registration number OR Email Id as entered by you at the time of registration.

12. **Briefly explain the selection process for the post of Diploma Trainee in NTPC.**

Reply: Eligible candidates will have to undergo 2 stages of Online Test (Computer Based Test).

1st stage online test: In first stage, Online Aptitude Test (120 multiple questions) covering General English, Quantitative aptitude & Reasoning will be conducted. The duration of the test will be 2 hours. Each question carries 1 mark and 0.25 marks will be deducted for wrong answer. There is qualifying marks (40% marks in case of General category and 30% in case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates). The candidates will be shortlisted @ 1:10 for 2nd Stage Online Test (Technical). There will be no weightage to online aptitude test in final selection.

2nd stage Online Test: In 2nd stage, Online Technical Test (120 multiple questions) in respective discipline will be conducted. The duration of the test will be 2 hours. Each question carries 1 mark and 0.25 marks will be deducted for wrong answer. There is qualifying marks (40% marks in case of General category and 30% in case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates). Offer of appointment may be issued based on merit. No skill test will be conducted.

13. **Briefly Explain the Selection Process for ITI Trainee /Lab Assistant Trainee(Chemistry) /Asst(Materials /Storekeeper)Trainee:**

Reply:

Eligible candidates will have to undergo Single Stage Online Test (Computer Based Test).

Single Stage Online Test: There will be one stage, Online Test (120 multiple questions). The test will be in two parts . Part-I will be Knowledge Test and will consist of 70 multiple choice questions of the relevant discipline as advertised. Part-II will be Aptitude Test and will consist of 50 multiple choice questions on General Awareness , English, Quantitative Aptitude & Reasoning . The duration of the test will be 2 hours. Each question carries 1 mark and 0.25 marks will be deducted for wrong answer. There is qualifying marks (General Candidates securing 40% marks in Knowledge Test and 30 % in Aptitude Test will be in the zone of consideration for further shortlisting for skill test. For SC/ST/OBC/PwBD candidates this criterion will be relaxed to the tune of 25% relative to that of General Candidates).

14. **If I applied for more than one Discipline/ Post , shall my candidature be considered for more than one Discipline / Post I have applied?**

Reply: No. In case a candidate has applied for more than one Discipline / Post or has applied multiple times, only his last application will be considered for further screening as the online test is to be conducted same day for all discipline / post. You are requested to avoid applying for more than one discipline / post.

15. **I have qualification of Diploma in Electronics & Telecommunication. For which discipline I shall apply?**

Reply: You can apply for C&I discipline. It is informed that students of Electrical & Electronics, Electronics & Telecommunication, Electronics, Electronics & Power, Electronics & Instrumentation, Control & Instrumentation can apply for C&I discipline.

16. **I am a qualified candidate meeting all the job requirement except my age is less than 18 years. Am I eligible to apply ?**

Reply: No. The minimum age for applying to the post is 18 years

17. **I am a Land Oustee of a Project/Station for which vacancies are not identified. Shall I apply against Land Oustee category?**

Reply:- No. You will not get any benefits extended to Darlipalli Project Displaced/ PAPs(Land Oustees). Earmarked vacancies are only extended to Darlipalli Project Displaced / PAP (Land Oustees) of the NTPC Darlipalli Project.

18. **I am NTPC Darlipalli Project Displaced / PAP(Land oustee). Shall I apply against Darlipalli Project Displaced/ PAP(Landousee) Category .**

Reply: Yes. Out of the published vacancies 30 % posts in Diploma Engineer Trainee and 60 % posts in ITI / Lab Assistant/ Assistant(Materials / Store Keeper) Trainee are earmarked for persons belonging to the category of NTPC Darlipalli Project Displaced/ PAP (Land Oustee). The same shall be governed in terms of Provisions of Rehabilitation & Resettlement Plan for Darlipalli STPP-Stage-I as approved in RPDAC Meeting in 2014, Orissa Resettlement & Rehabilitation Policy-2006, Guidelines of Industry Dept, Govt. of Odisha-2009, Govt. of Odisha R&DM Dept Clarification related to Odisha R&R Policy , Dated: 20.10.2010, RPDAC Agreements of NTPC Darlipalli etc., as applicable.
